## 2018-19 KNIGHT NOTES

• Johnny Dawkins took over a 12-18 team at UCF that hadn't finished above .500 since the 2012-13 season. He led the Knights to back-to-back winning seasons, totaling 43 wins.

• After leading UCF to a 24-12 record and a trip to the NIT semifinals in 2016-17, Dawkins was named a finalist for the 2017 Ben Jobe and Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year awards.

• While he was hurt with a shoulder injury much of last season, Tacko Fall is still as dominating a presence as there is in college basketball. The 7-foot-6 center was the 2017 American Athletic Conference Defensive Player of the Year and earned Defensive All-America honors.

• The Knights also return leading scorer B.J. Taylor, who has led UCF in all three of his seasons on the court. An all-conference point guard, Taylor led the Knights with 15.9 points per game as a junior.

• After sitting out two full seasons, Coach Dawkins' son Aubrey will finally see the court in Orlando. A transfer from Michigan who missed all of 2017-18 due to injury, Dawkins averaged 6.5 points per game while playing in every contest as a sophomore with the Wolverines.

• The Knights have got it done on defense in the first two years with Dawkins at the helm. In 2016-17 UCF led the nation in field goal percentage, holding opponents to just 36.5 percent from the floor. Last season the Knights ranked third in the nation in allowing just 61.7 points per game.
